



## ROGER MILLER

Roger developed and printed his first roll of film in 1960 as a high school student and has been actively shooting ever since. He currently shoots for Pacific Northwest Ballet's Costume Shop and some of those photos have been published in *Encore* magazine, on T-shirts, in PNB's annual report, and in various print and web advertising campaigns. He also shoots glamour photography in his home studio.

Roger grew up on an Iowa farm, earned an Associate in Applied Science certificate in the field of Electronics Technology and then repaired mainframe computers for Honeywell. He returned to school but was drafted into the Vietnam War. He eventually received a degree in Electrical Engineering from Iowa State University of Science and Technology and then worked as a systems analyst for Sperry Univac (now Unisys) for 7 years. He moved to Bremerton in 1979 where he worked for the Naval Undersea Warfare Center until he retired in 2006.

Roger shoots primarily with Canon equipment, sometimes shooting as many as 15,000 images per year. He has become proficient with Photoshop and related image processing software. He is also proficient with Dreamweaver software which he uses as webmaster for the f:67 Camera Club's web site.

Besides amateur photography, Roger's other hobbies include amateur astronomy and amateur radio (he holds an Amateur Extra Class license).
