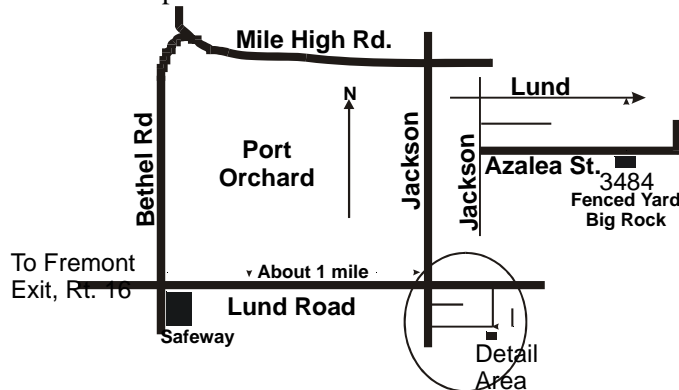

PHOTO-TOPICS

The f:67 exhibition categories for November, December and January are defined here. Note that print category "Open" is now defined under "General".

GENERAL

Any subject is acceptable.

NATURE –

All creatures and plants that are wild species and not modified by man. Also included are natural phenomena, geological formations, archaeology, astronomy, and weather. Other nature information:-- Images depicting nature adapting to the impact of man are acceptable provided the human element enhances the nature story, and the above standards are followed. Images of wild species in a controlled environment are acceptable provided they accurately depict a natural scene. Photographs of stuffed specimens and obviously set arrangements are not acceptable.

STILL-LIFE –

An arrangement of stationary elements, where subject arrangement and illumination have been significantly determined and controlled by the maker.

CREATIVE (CONTEMPORARY) –

Abstractions, patterns, and designs or a photograph that depicts subjects in a *departure-from-realism* through the use of various techniques, controls and processes.
